Hifz Boot Camp - Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced Level	Summer is often dreaded time for parents as they are afraid of their child losing their Hifz skills. This class would not only revise the previous memorization of the Qur'an but it would improve and help to memorize new Suras. Also, it would provide an opportunity for the child to start memorizing the Qur'an. There is no pre-requisite for this course.	5-14 years / Placement based on assessment	\$50/week or \$300 for 7 weeks	Class time: 8:00am - 10:00am (Monday through Friday)						
Qur'an Recitation	In this course your child will learn the recitation of the Holy Qur'an with proper Tajweed rules. No previous knowledge or experience is needed.	5-14 years	\$30/week or \$160 for 7 weeks	Class time: 10:00am - 11:00am (Monday through Friday)						
Meanings of Qur'an	This course will present an introduction to learning the meanings of Qur'an. Each week will focus on one or two Surahs, where students learn their history and Tafsir, along with vocabulary and some basic grammar. By the end of the week, the students should develop an in-depth relationship with these Surahs.	5-14 years	\$30/week or \$160 for 7 weeks	Class time: 10:00am - 11:00am (Monday through Friday)						
Pre-School Scholars - I	Preschool is a precious time of learning through fun and activities. In this course your preschooler will learn reading, math, and science. It will also include	3-5 years	\$100/week or \$600 for 7 weeks	Class time: 8:00am - 12:00pm (Monday through Friday)						
Pre-School Scholars - II	activities that will nurture your child's social skills as well as physical and emotional development. Theater and Drama	In this class, children are introduced to theater skills such as acting fundamentals, learning to speak on stage, using drama exercises by playing theater games, learn to work in peer groups, and meet new friends. Students will enjoy these hands-on classes where participation is encouraged and essential for learning. It's a great way for children to learn, have fun and gain valuable skills in theater arts such as self-confidence, cooperation, self-discipline, and concentration.	5-14 years	\$50/week or \$300 for 7 weeks	Class time: 12:00pm - 1:30pm (Monday through Friday)						

Math Genius	The success in any field of studies depends on the student's interest in Math. This course would inspire and develop the love for Math. Students will have an opportunity to learn Math skills via interactive games and fun. The course would also include mental Math, brain teaser, analogy, logic, etc.	5-14 years	\$50/week or \$300 for 7 weeks	Class time: 12:00pm - 1:30pm (Monday through Friday)
Speech and Debate	The speech and debate class teaches the basics of public speaking and argumentation, allowing kids to develop core presentation and debating skills that boost confidence and self-esteem. Students get the chance to improve their communication skills in a challenging, safe and secure environment that's suited to each child's age and experience level.	5-14 years	\$50/week or \$300 for 7 weeks	Class time: 1:30pm - 3:00pm (Monday through Friday)
Chef in the Making	Students will learn cooking and baking skills, knife skills, and safety skills under adult supervision. They will prepare two of their favorite dishes per week - one savory and one dessert from various cultures and traditions. Open for both boys and girls. This course will be run by a professional chef.	5-14 years	\$50/week or \$300 for 7 weeks	Class time: 1:30pm - 3:00pm (Monday through Friday)
Journey through Islam	This course covers a wide variety of topics in Islam, giving students a firm background in Islamic knowledge. Students will study topics including the basics of Islam, the Prophets and their leadership, the Seerah, the Sahabah, Qur'anic stories, manners, and the Hereafter. Students will also give presentations, which will improve their presentation and leadership skills.	5-14 years	\$50/week or \$300 for 7 weeks	Class time: 3:00pm - 4:30pm (Monday through Friday)
Islamic Calligraphy and Arts and Crafts	Let not this summer go by without learning the beautiful art of Arabic Calligraphy. For hundreds of years artists have mastered the careful and delicate art of Arabic Calligraphy and it is important that we teach our children to appreciate the beauty of Arabic writings and learn this art. Students will learn in an environment that encourages a sense of ingenuity and creativity.	5-14 years	\$50/week or \$300 for 7 weeks	Class time: 3:00pm - 4:30pm (Monday through Friday)

- Each class must have a minimum number of 5 students enrolled for it to continue as scheduled. No more than 15 students will be accepted per class.
- No class will be held on Wednesday, July 4, 2019.
- A sibling discount of 5% is available for the second child and 10% for each sibling thereafter.
- A discount of 10% is available for a student who is enrolled for all classes during the day.
- Student projects will be displayed at a closing ceremony at the end of summer program. A detailed description of this program will be provided at the onset of classes.
